

Outdoor Worship Service

We are excited to provide an **outdoor worship service**, Sunday's at 9:00 a.m. by gathering together and worshipping God as a church family while still making sure that we are responsible and safe. To provide for your safety, Church Re-opening Task Force members will be available to answer questions the day of the service.

To join us for the service, the information you will need is below.

What to bring:

- **Your own lawn chair and/or blankets. The church will not be providing them.**
- Masks for all members in your party. Masks will be required before, during, and after the service. If you forget to bring yours, there will be a limited number available.

Service Location and Parking

- Seating 6 feet apart, will be on the lawn by the creek in the front of the sanctuary. The worship team and pulpit will be set up under the portico/porch in front of the sanctuary.
- Parking will be in the parking lot but if members of your party have mobility issues, you may drop them off at the marked entrance on the grass.

Bathrooms and Closed areas of Church

- The only bathrooms that will be open are those near Rickner Hall/auditorium. We are requiring only 2 people at a time in each bathroom to comply with social distancing.
- The sanctuary, classrooms, choir room, BCIU wing and offices will be closed to members.

Family and Children's Seating

- Family members must sit together on the lawn. Seating will be marked at 6 foot intervals complying with social distancing.
- Children will sit with their parents the entire service (~45 minutes). **There will not be a Children's sermon nor any children's activities.**
- Additional seating will be on the circular driveway at 6 foot intervals.

Bulletins

- On the day of the service, you can download the bulletin from the church website to your phone or tablet, or print it at home. Very limited copies will be available.

Participation in Worship

- If you wish to sing and join in prayers, please do so in a quiet manner. **Masks must remain on.**

If you chose not to come, you may continue to view the online worship service. Donna's children's message will also be a part of that service as it has been in the past.

This is a beginning step to come together in fellowship. If you come, we hope that you will enjoy it! See you there July 12!
